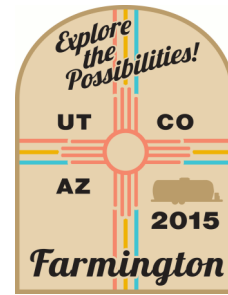

## Severe Weather AND Emergency Procedures Farmington, NM 2015

### SEVERE WEATHER PROCEDURES

1. In case of severe weather, you will be notified by Traffic Control (TC) personnel and you should proceed to the Convention Center, building #2 immediately.
  2. It is recommended that you secure awnings, flags and all loose items around your RV.
  3. Pets may be taken to the building, but you must be prepared to accommodate their needs.
  4. Any time there is bad weather and you have not been notified by TC personnel, you may proceed to building #2 if you feel unsafe in your RV.
  5. When it is safe, an all-clear will be announced by TC personnel.
2. Give your name, location (McGee Park) lot number and your RV number.
  3. Turn on your headlights, emergency flashers and have a neighbor stand by to direct emergency personnel to your sight.
  4. **YOUR RV NUMBER MUST BE PROMINENTLY DISPLAYED ON YOUR RV SO EMERGENCY PERSONNEL CAN LOCATE YOUR RV AS QUICKLY AS POSSIBLE.**

### SECURITY

### EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

1. In case of an emergency for any reason, please call 911.
1. The McGee Park is a very secure and safe place, but it is always best to take necessary precautions to protect your property.
2. It is recommended that you keep all your RV compartments locked as well as your vehicle.
3. Keep all bicycles, scooters, etc. locked when not in use.
4. The local Law Enforcement and McGee Park Security will be patrolling the area.

As stated in the Pre Rally Schedule, trash will be picked up at 7:00 AM in front of your rig. If after 7:00 AM when put out, please put in trash barrels located in each RV lot.

Recycle bins will be in place on June 16th in front of the MUB.
